

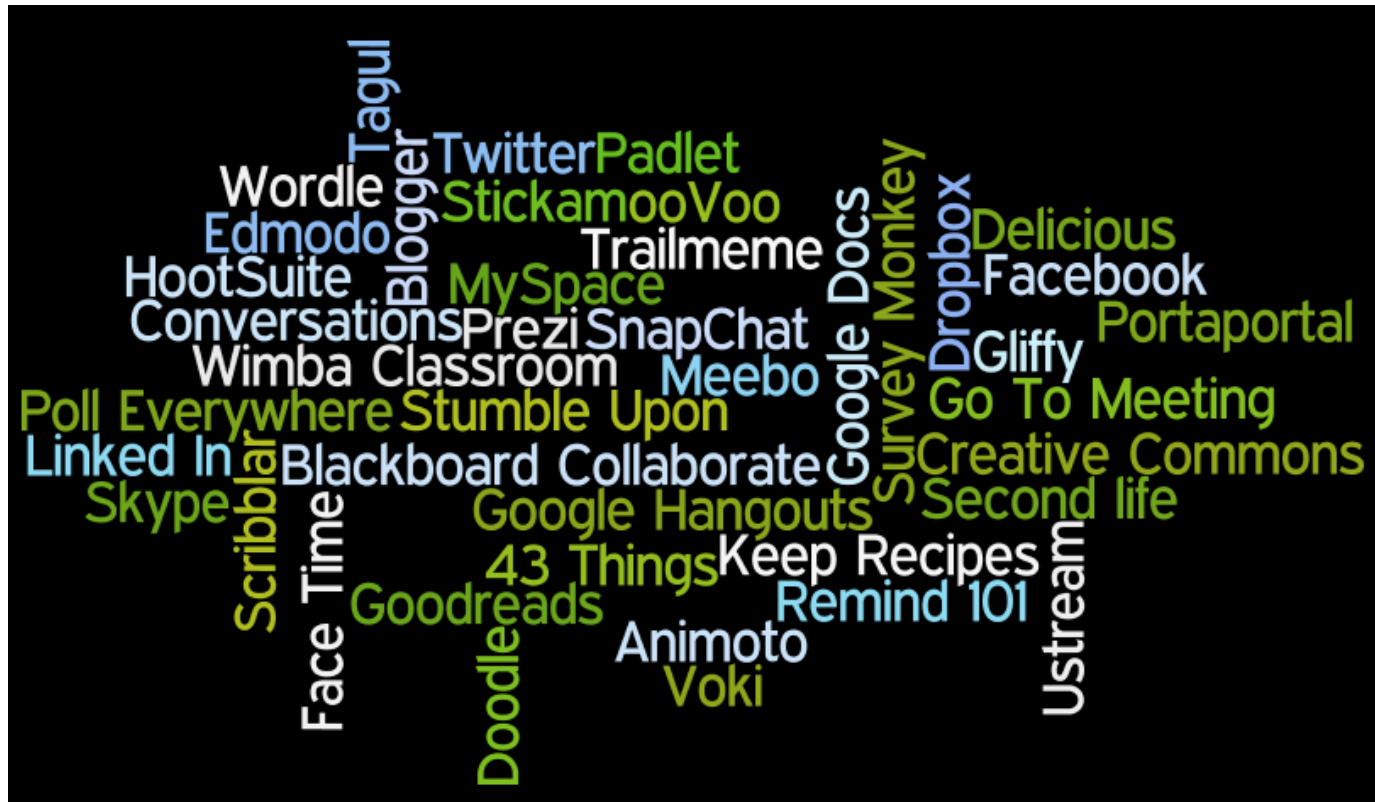

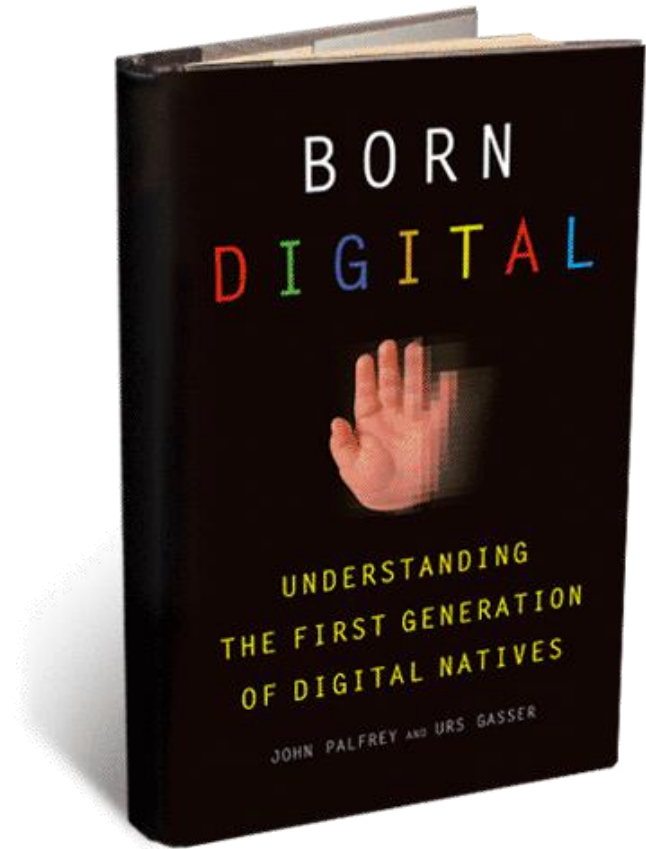

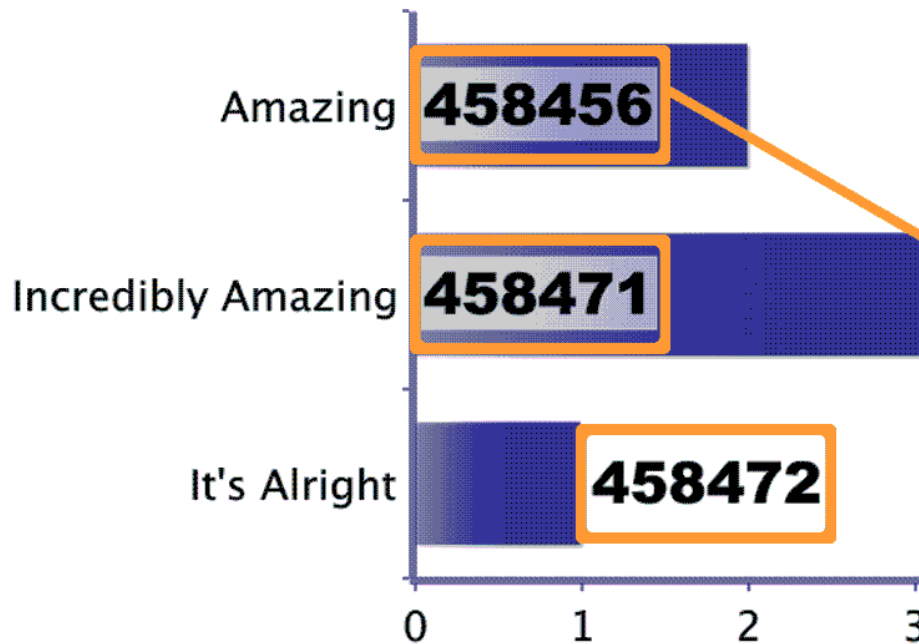

EXAMPLE

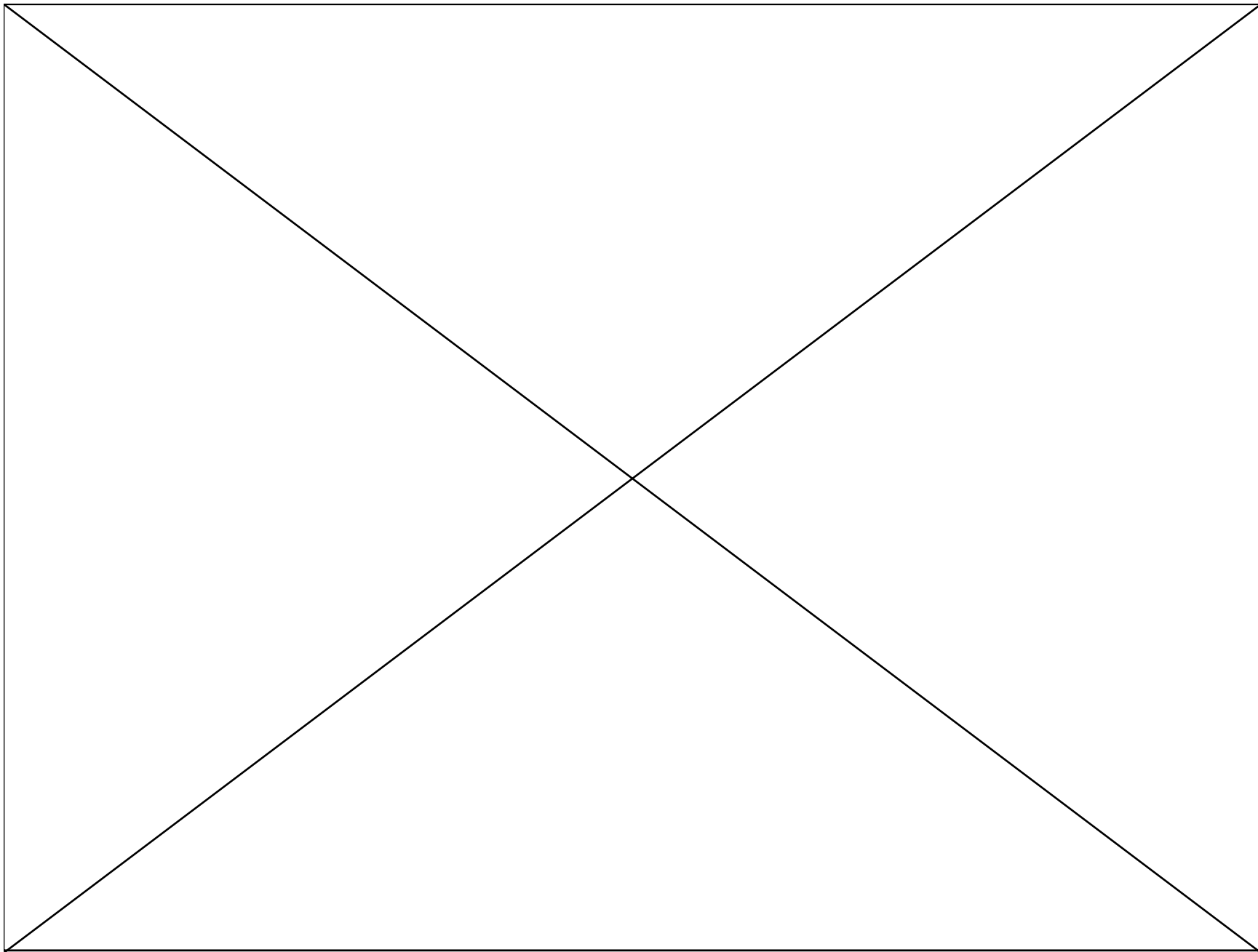
How do you like my presentation so far?

Text a **CODE** to **37607**



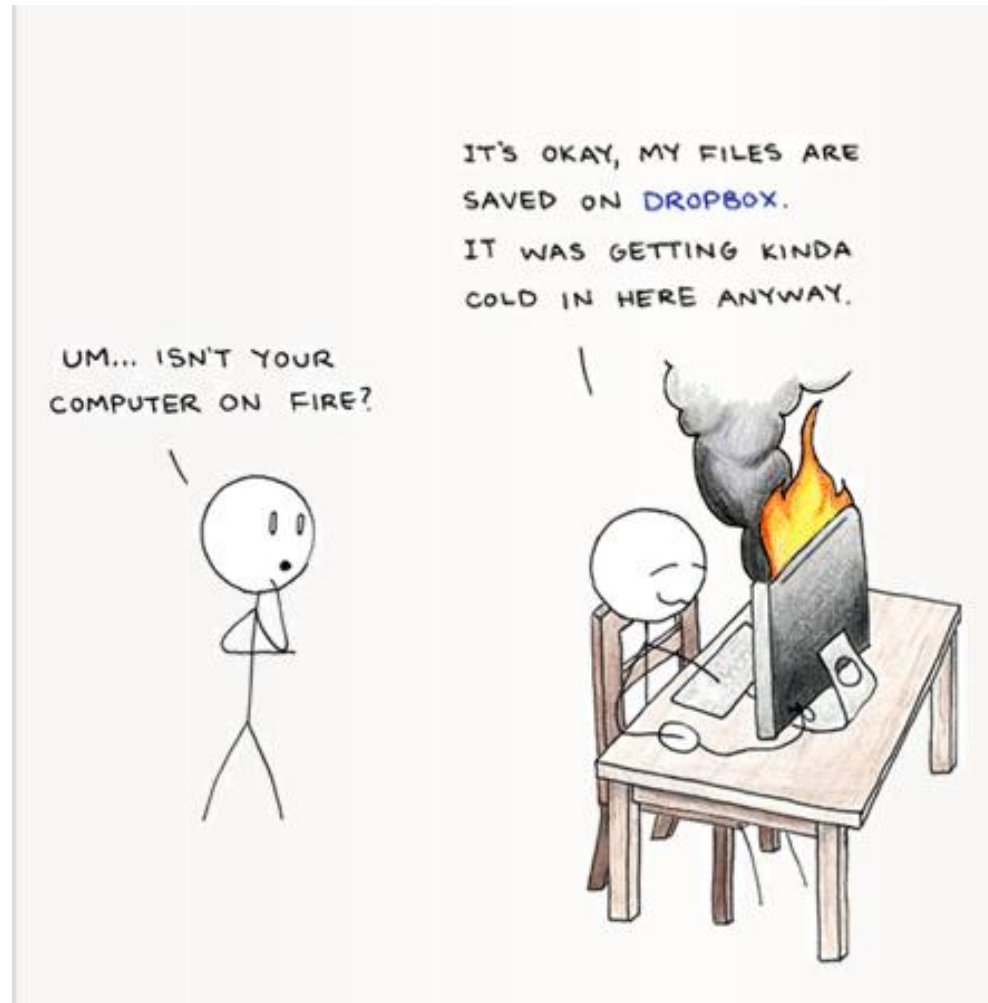
TIPS

3. Capitalization doesn't matter, but spaces and spelling do



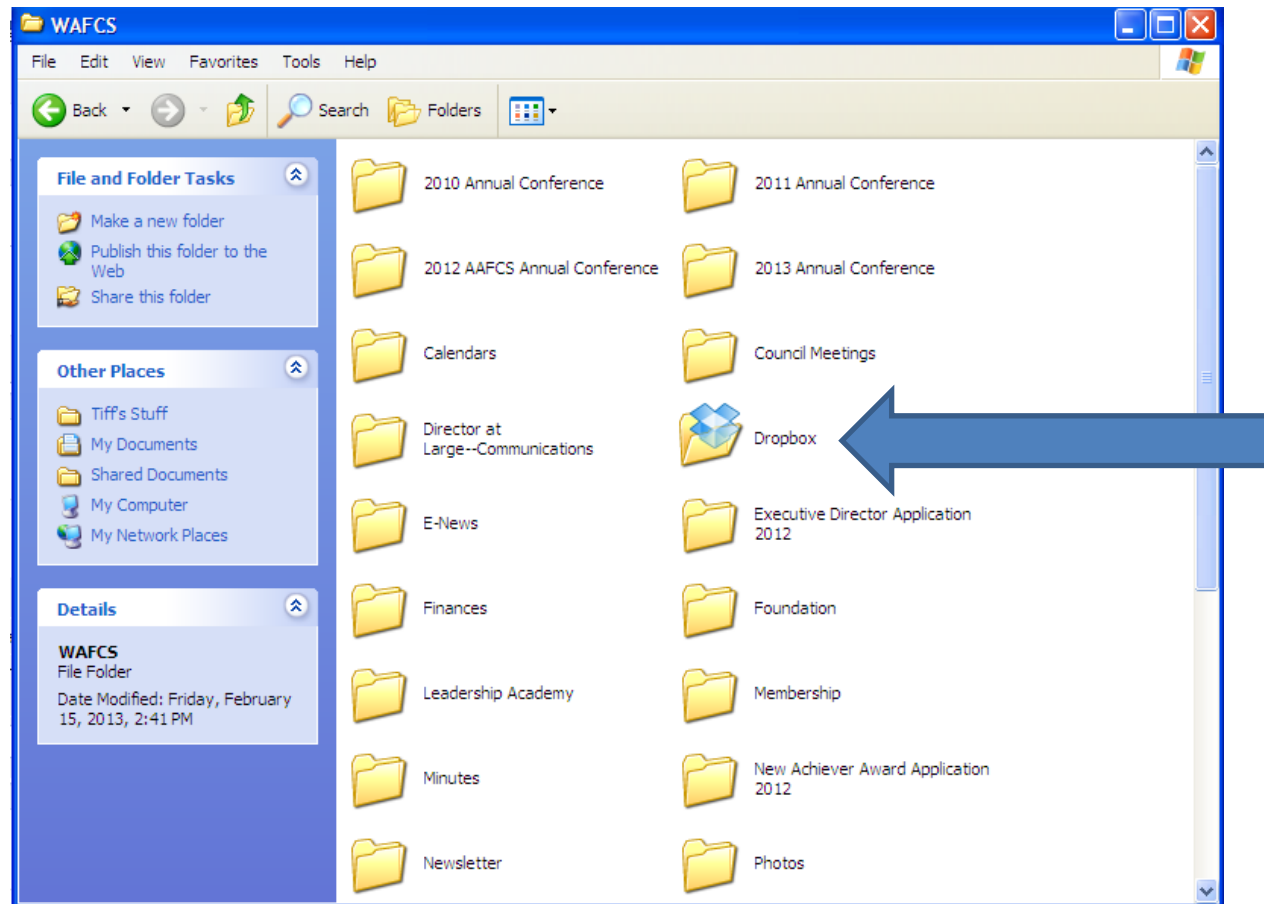

Technology Implementation Tips

- Plan ahead and get to know the technology before teaching or presenting.
- Remember...free today, gone tomorrow.
- Google Chrome and Mozilla Firefox tend to be more user friendly browsers.
- Always look for the “educational” version of applications. They often provide free additional storage or features.
- Find ways to promote troubleshooting and problem solving by students and clients.
- Involve students and clients in critically evaluating technology tools.
- Be flexible and have a back-up plan.
