Professional Project/Research Grant Application Form



The Wisconsin Association of Family and Consumer Sciences Foundation will award **up to \$1,000** in grant money for a professional project or research grant proposal related to the field of family and consumer sciences. Applicants must hold a bachelor's degree and be a current member of the American Association of Family and Consumer Sciences (AAFCS) and the Wisconsin Association of Family and Consumer Sciences (WAFCS). The grant recipient will acknowledge the grantor and share his/her project/research findings or results with the AAFCS/WAFCS membership via a WAFCS newsletter article and/or presentation at a WAFCS and/or AAFCS Annual Conference.

To apply for a grant, applicants should submit a one- to two-page proposal to WAFCS Foundation Chair, Karen Goebel, CFCS, **no later than February 15**.

Proposals must include:

- Name, address, phone number, e-mail address, and AAFCS member number of applicant(s);
- Project description and objectives (or statement of problem and justification, research objectives, and methodology or procedure);
- Proposed time frame for the project/research;
- Amount requested with rationale for request, e.g., how grant funds will be used;
- Plan for dissemination of project results/research findings.

The grant recipient will be announced at the WAFCS Annual Conference. See WAFCS website (www.wafcs.org) for dates.
