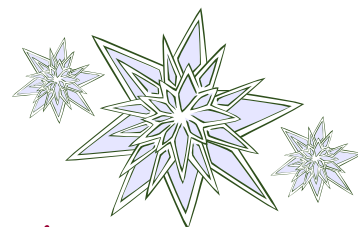

DIY holiday decoration, chocolate covered strawberries, and crochet mug koozies are just some of my favorite easy holiday crafts that I love to share.

DIY Holiday Decoration



Directions:

- Paint old bottles white.
- Stencil J, snowflake, and Y.
- Add evergreens, berries, tiny bulbs, or whatever you please.



Chocolate Covered Strawberries



Directions:

- Melt desired chocolate in a glass bowl.
- Hold strawberry stem and dip it into the chocolate.
- Lay dipped strawberries on wax paper.
- Dip fork in desired melted colored candy and drizzle over strawberry.
- Let strawberry harden on wax paper
- Serve in cupcake papers.

Crochet Mug Koozie

Size: I/9-5.50mm needle

Yarn: Medium, Red Heart

Directions:

- Chain enough stitches to compensate for the height of your mug (leave a little room at top).
- Double crochet or use whatever pattern you please to make a rectangle around the mug.
- Continue around the mug until it is a little shy of the other side of the handle (you want it stretchy).
- When it is the desired length, slip stitch through in two stitches at both ends so it is secure and the handle will fit through.
